## **REFERRAL DOCUMENT LODGED**

### **BLACKBUSH PROSPECT Mullaquana Uranium Project Eyre Peninsula, South Australia**

UraniumSA advises that it has recently submitted its “Referral of Proposed Action for an In-situ Recovery Field Trial - Mullaquana Project” to the Commonwealth Department of Sustainability, Environment, Water, Population and Communities. This is the first piece of documentation in a regulatory process administered by Commonwealth and State regulatory agencies that UraniumSA needs to complete to be allowed to commence its proposed in-situ recovery field trial at the Blackbush Deposit.

The document can be viewed on the EPBC website under “Recent Notices” on their home page. The Act guidelines and the referral process are described in the “Environmental Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999” which can be viewed at the EPBC web site under “about the EPBC Act”.

It is anticipated that the Department of Sustainability, Environment, Water, Population and Communities will respond within 20 working days.

Meanwhile, the Company is progressing work on the development of documentation supporting an application for a Retention Lease (a type of mining lease) which will be sought under the South Australian Government’s Mining Act.

At the Blackbush Prospect, UraniumSA is continuing work to determine its amenability to in-situ recovery mining. Further metallurgical test work is in progress, local and regional hydrogeological pump testing has been completed and results will be available shortly.

Elsewhere in the Mullaquana Project, exploration drilling continues to intersect potentially economic uranium mineralisation.

## About UraniumSA Limited



UraniumSA is an Adelaide based uranium only explorer specialising in sediment hosted styles of uranium mineralisation within a substantial portfolio of properties in South Australia's Gawler Craton.

The Company has discovered sediment hosted uranium mineralisation within its Mullaquana Project, 20km south of the industrial city of Whyalla on the eastern Eyre Peninsula. The Blackbush Prospect has an Inferred Mineral Resource of 45.5Mt at 280ppm eU<sub>3</sub>O<sub>8</sub> with an estimated 12,700t contained U<sub>3</sub>O<sub>8</sub>. The Company is working to advance the Blackbush Prospect to an in-situ recovery field trial as soon as practicable. Continuing drilling to expand the resource base is obtaining intersections significantly above deposit average grade and thickness. The objective is to expand the resource base through incremental addition and new discovery.

Through its own tenure and by Joint Venture the Company has exploration control over what it considers the most prospective portions of the Pirie Basin.
