# Mayor welcomes unique uranium find

Whyalla City Council has welcomed the discovery of a unique uranium deposit on the Mullaquana tenement saying it would create jobs.

However, all explorations would be closely monitored for environmental impacts.

Mayor Jim Pollock said he was made aware of the discovery

through a press release and Uranium SA was yet to contact the council.

He said while the discovery was made on the outskirts of the city boundary its impact on the town was yet to be known.

"As usual the council will closely monitor the drilling and the exploration process and keep in

touch with Uranium SA on the progress," Mr Pollock said.

"From an economic point of view this is great news because it will create jobs and our people will benefit.

"We are looking forward to having discussions with Uranium SA to get more details."
