## Uranium project fast tracked

UraniumSA Limited is looking into fast tracking its field trials at Mullaquana which was initially scheduled for mid next year.

Company managing director Russel Bluck said the field leach trials will begin as soon as practicable.

He said the company is also continuing to grow the tonnage, grade and contained uranium of the Blackbush Prospect at Mullaquana.

Mr Bluck said the company has adequate cash reserves, strong management and financial controls and a demonstrated ability to grow its asset

base.

He said the board's policy is to give preference to shareholders in its capital raising and expand the range of exploration targets.

"The exploration objective within the Mullaquana project as a whole is to drill out the minimum exploration target of 50 to 80 million tonnes of uranium mineralisation," Mr Bluck said.

Over the next six months the company intends to discover new prospects at similar grades.
