



## Uranium SA reaches out to Whyalla

Have you been concerned about the uranium project at Mullaquana?

This is your chance to ask questions, raise concerns and get a feedback.

Uranium SA is organising a series of display booths and community engagement meetings from Thursday.

Company managing director Russel Bluck will be in Whyalla to talk about the uranium discovery and how the project will be developed through trials towards possible production.

UraniumSA discovered uranium mineralisation at Mullaquana in December 2007 and is now

working towards a field leach trial to determine if the uranium can be extracted by the in-situ recovery (ISR) process.

No commercial uranium is produced or exported at this stage.

As part of this work the company is doing more drilling to establish the size of its Blackbush Prospect and studies of the environment and ground waters in the area.

"The company is working through the requirements of State and Federal government agencies to meet the regulatory requirements to conduct the field leach trials." Mr Bluck said.
