



## Uranium SA prepares for public information night

The UraniumSA team will be in Whyalla for two public information sessions on May 4 and 5.

Members of public will have the chance to ask questions after the presentations and get first hand answers from field workers and executives.

Mullaquana Project general manager Alistair Muir was raised and educated in Whyalla.

He has been a geologist and boasts more than 20 years' experience in new and existing mining projects

principally in South Australia.

Mullaquana site supervisor Julian Snook was a member of the crew that drilled the discovery hole at Mullaquana in 2007.

As site supervisor Julian is responsible for the day-to-day operations on the Mullaquana Project.

UraniumSA discovered uranium mineralisation at Mullaquana in December 2007 and is now working towards a field trial to determine if the uranium can be extracted by the

in-situ recovery (ISR) process (no commercial uranium is produced or exported at this stage).

The company is currently in the process of meeting regulatory requirements to gain state and federal approvals to conduct a field trial.

The meetings on both days will begin at 4pm and end at 8pm at the Whyalla Yacht Club.

After a short presentation about the project and its progress, questions will be answered.
