Uranium SA reaches out to the community

Uranium SA has started reaching out to the community and has caught up with members of a few clubs and the Environment Consultation Group (ECG).

ECG chairperson Eddie Hughes said he was happy with the meeting and will continue to be in touch with the group.

He said he was happy with the company's presentation and gave assurance that the marine environment would not be affected by the mining process.
