Uranium SA hosts tour for equity holders

Last week Uranium SA provided a tour of its site at Mullaquana to long-term equity holders.

The group of shareholders included Warwick Grigor of BGF equities, who is Australia's leading uranium analysts.

Mr Bluck said Mr Grigor had been in support of Uranium SA's project for 'quite some time'.

"Warwick has introduced quite a number of the capital major shareholders who are here with us today to the company," Mr Bluck said.

"Warwick's probably the best informed of the uranium analysts in Australia.

"He hasn't been on the ground here before so it's an opportunity for him to get a look at the physical asset that he's been supporting and talk to the experts and people that we have working on the project that are generating the information that's making this project such an attractive one."

Mr Bluck said while many of those who took part on the tour last week had been to the site before, they had been interested to see what was going on.

"Very few of the people have been to the site before," he said.

"A lot of them are quite knowledgeable mining industry investors and analysts, and it is good, there have been no negatives.

"But we have had lots of hard questions, as I'd expect."
