## Uranium SA promises transparency to the community

Uranium SA is determined to remain open and transparent with the community.

Uranium SA managing director Russel Bluck said since the start of its project at Mullaquana, Uranium SA had been aware of concern about the project from residents.

"This is a uranium project so there's a spread of opinion," he said.

"Most of it is interested and concerned but not horrendously obsessed or worried about it.

"There are people who have intractable concerns about uranium and all we can do is be as open and transparent as we can, but overall the general community seems to be supportive of the potential operation."

Mr Bluck said he believed the community had received sufficient levels of consultation, and Uranium SA was happy to answer any

questions the community had.

"We've spent a lot of time talking in the community, being out on street corners talking to people, talking to all the local community managers," he said.

"Alistair Muir, our general manager here, has spent a lot of time with rotary clubs and all community organisations.

"We've had general public meetings.

"They're [the community] determined that we're going to be open and transparent and not try and hide what we're doing and we're trying not to do that.

"Our concept is that we can't expect anyone to believe us, we have to be able to demonstrate that if you've got a question we've got to show the information and answer it, we're not trying to hide anything."
