## UraniumSA progress well with Samphire project

UraniumSA has made progress with its development of the Blackbush deposit at the Samphire uranium project.

It has made progress with its circulation trial, with field operations for the well filed circulation trial at the Blackbush deposit commencing.

An initial program of development and well integrity testing has been followed by a first period of pumping and data collection.

A second phase of pumping and data collection is scheduled to commence this week to complete this round of field operations.

Initial assessment has indicated good control of

circulation and recovery has been achieved.

The work is expected to be completed and reported through ASX by late November.

UraniumSA has also completed its second column leach trial at the Australian Nuclear Science and Technology Organisation laboratories (ANSTO) testing the closed circuit circulation of lixiviant.

The operation of the trial and the results obtained were as anticipated and consistent with the results from the first trial.

Results are being assessed and are expected to be reported through ASX in November this year.

The uranium loading characteristics for nine ion exchange resins have now been determined by ANSTO.

Four of the resins have been selected for elution and precipitation test work.

The best performing of these resins will be used in the planned filed leach trial.

Results will be reported as they become available.

Public comment on the Samphire Uranium retention lease application closed on October 13.

PIRSA has provided a two week time extension to enable the completion of late submissions.
